FIRST VIRTUAL COFFEE WITH PWD GENERAL MANAGER SET FOR NOV. 18

Palmdale, CA – Palmdale Water District (PWD) General Manager

Dennis D. LaMoreaux will hold a Facebook Live event next week to give customers the opportunity to ask him questions and to be accessible at a time when the PWD lobby has been closed to walk-in traffic since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Facebook Live event will be on PWD’s Facebook page, @palmdaleh2o, from 9-9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 18. The GM will give an update on PWD’s finances, water supply, and engineering projects. Written questions can be submitted as Facebook messages before or during the virtual event.

“I want to use this time to check in and update our customers virtually,” LaMoreaux said. “We have had to limit our lobby to appointments only due to the global pandemic. So to continue upholding our pledge to transparency and accountability, I will be available to answer

LaMoreaux has worked for more than 30 years with special districts in California. Aside from a short time with Rosamond Community Services District, he has spent most of his career at PWD, where he started in 1989 as the Assistant General Manager. As the General Manager, he is responsible for overseeing the District’s day-to-day operations and business functions according to the direction and policies established by the Board of Directors.

His previous employment includes private engineering consulting firms in California and Wyoming, where he was involved in the design and inspection of various projects. A native of Ohio, he graduated from the University of Wyoming in 1984 with a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering and is a licensed Civil Engineer in California.
