Executive Director LaMoreaux stated last month the Sanitation District completed a contract with the Palmdale Water District for recycled water that will ramp up to 5,325 acre feet over a number of years. Both entities will work together to coordinate transfer of the City of Palmdale's 1,600 acre feet to the Authority. Once the transfers are done there will be nearly 7,000 acres of recycled water for customers.
