PWD's COFFEE WITH DIRECTOR VINCENT DINO SLATED FOR **NOVEMBER 20**

Palmdale, CA – Palmdale Water District (PWD) Board President Vincent Dino will meet with constituents and answer questions at Coffee with a PWD Director from 9-11 a.m. Wednesday, November 20, at Starbucks, 38135 47th Street East, Suite 605, in Palmdale.

Coffee with a PWD Director events give customers the opportunity to meet their representatives and ask water-related questions in a casual environment. PWD will buy the first cup of coffee for community members who attend.

Director Dino also will be on Facebook Live from 10-10:30 a.m. on PWD's Facebook page, @palmdaleh2o. Written questions may be submitted as Facebook messages and will be answered.

"Community engagement is very important to me, and these coffee events have been a great way to engage and talk to the people we represent," Director Dino said. "I want to have a cup of coffee with anyone interested in (more)

finding out information about PWD and what it is that we do. I hope to share some water knowledge with my community. Stop by and talk water with me."

A San Fernando transplant, Director Dino has lived in Palmdale since 1993. He is a retired Journeyman Electrician of 35 years and had served on the Palmdale Planning Commission for eight years, including two terms as chairman. He serves as Sergeant at Arms of the Grandsons of Italy in America Club, which honored him as "Man of the Year" in 2011. First elected to the Board in 2013, he won re-election in 2018. His second term runs through 2022.

Director Dino represents Division 5, an area that roughly lies between Avenue P to the north, Avenue S to the south, 75th Street to the east and 30th Street to the west. This coffee with a Director event concludes the sessions for this year.
