MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PALMDALE WATER DISTRICT, AUGUST 23, 2017:

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Palmdale Water District was held Wednesday, August 23, 2017, at 2029 East Avenue Q, Palmdale, California, in the Board Room of the District office. President, Robert Alvarado, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

1) Pledge of Allegiance/Moment of Silence.

At the request of President Alvarado, Public Affairs Director Shay led the pledge of allegiance followed by a moment of silence in honor of our troops and law enforcement.

2) Roll Call.

3) Adoption of Agenda.

President Alvarado stated that Agenda Item No. 11.2 can be removed from the agenda and requested that Agenda Item No.'s 9 through 12 be considered after Agenda Item No. 4. He then stated that an item arose after the posting of the agenda for tonight's meeting and requires action prior to the time of the next regular Board meeting and requested that "Consideration and possible action on opposition to SB 623" be added to tonight's agenda as Agenda Item No. 7.9.

General Counsel Dunn then provided a brief overview of SB 623, the proposed statewide water tax, after which it was moved by Director Henriquez, seconded by Director Mac Laren, and unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting to adopt the agenda, as amended, removing Agenda Item No. 11.2, considering Agenda Item No.'s 9 through 12 after Agenda Item No. 4, and adding Agenda Item No. 7.9.

Mr. David Palmer, Palmdale resident, presented information about NASA's Gravity Recovery and Climate Experiment mission and how this mission has proven to detect water underground.

President Alvarado announced the items included in the Consent Calendar after which it was moved by Director Mac Laren and seconded by Director Estes to approve those items included in the Consent Calendar.

At the request of Director Henriquez, General Manager LaMoreaux briefly reviewed Agenda Item No.'s 6.5 and 6.6 after which the motion was unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting.

Copies of Resolution No.'s 17-18, 17-19, and 17-20 are hereby made a portion of the minutes of this meeting.

- 7) Action Items Action Calendar (The Public Shall Have an Opportunity to Comment on Any Action Item as Each Item is Considered by the Board of Directors Prior to Action Being Taken.)
- 7.1) Status Report on Cash Flow Statement and Current Cash Balances as of June, 2017. (Financial Advisor Egan/Finance Committee)

General Manager LaMoreaux reviewed the investment funds report as of June, 2017 including the reduction in cash due to the Butte payment, maturing and replacement CDs, and decrease in 2013A Water Revenue Bond funds and then provided an overview of the cash flow statement including the Butte payment, capital improvement fees received in July, and projected 2017 year-end cash.

7.2) Status Report on Financial Statements, Revenue, and Expense and Departmental Budget Reports for June, 2017. (Finance Manager Williams)

General Manager LaMoreaux reviewed the balance sheet and profit and loss statements and stated that most departments are operating at or below the targeted expenditure percentage of 50% with revenues and expenditures under this target; that customers are returning to pre-drought water use patterns; and that staff is doing a good job of controlling expenditures to match revenue.

7.3) Discussion and Overview of Committed Contracts Issued and Water Revenue Bond Projects. (Finance Manager Williams)

General Manager LaMoreaux provided an overview of the updated Contractual Commitments and Needs for 2017 capital projects, consulting and engineering support projects, new and replacement equipment, water quality fee funded projects, committed and projected capital expenditures, available funding sources, and remaining Water Revenue Bond Series 2013A funds and payments to date followed by discussion of the Upper Amargosa Recharge Project and the security system project at the Leslie O. Carter Water Treatment Plant.

7.4) Consideration and Possible Action on Setting Palmdale Water District's Assessment Rates for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 and Adoption of Resolution No. 17-21 Regarding Said Rates. (Financial Advisor Egan)

General Manager LaMoreaux provided an overview of the assessment rates for fiscal year 2017-2018, and after a brief discussion, it was moved by Director Estes,

seconded by Director Henriquez, and unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting to approve Resolution No. 17-21 being a Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Palmdale Water District setting the Palmdale Water District's Assessment Rates for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 at 0.265906.

A copy of Resolution No. 17-21 is hereby made a portion of the minutes of this meeting.

7.5) Consideration and Possible Action on Resolution No. 17-22 Being a Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Palmdale Water District Authorizing the Purchase of Tax Defaulted Properties. (\$13,704.00 – Budgeted – Engineering/Grant Manager Riley)

General Manager LaMoreaux provided an overview of the opportunity to purchase tax defaulted properties, and after a brief discussion of the cost, location and intended use of the properties, it was moved by Director Mac Laren, seconded by Director Henriquez, and unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting to approve Resolution No. 17-22 being a Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Palmdale Water District Authorizing the Purchase of Tax Defaulted Properties.

A copy of Resolution No. 17-22 is hereby made a portion of the minutes of this meeting.

7.6) Consideration and Possible Action on Revisions to Appendix T "Facility Tour Policy" of the Palmdale Water District's Rules and Regulations. (No Budget Impact – Public Affairs Director Shay)

Public Affairs Director Shay provided an overview of recommended revisions to the District's Facility Tour Policy after which it was moved by Director Mac Laren and seconded by Director Dino to approve revisions to Appendix T "Facility Tour Policy" of the Palmdale Water District's Rules and Regulations.

Mr. David Palmer, Palmdale resident, then recommended the District restrict tours to Palmdale Water District customers, and after a further discussion, the motion was unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting.

7.7) Consideration and Possible Action on Outreach Activities for 2017. (Public Affairs Director Shay)

a) Update on 100th Year Anniversary Events.

Public Affairs Director Shay shared the District's 3rd place ribbon for the Antelope Valley Fair's Dress and Decorate contest and the 1st place trophy for the District's float entry in the Antelope Valley Fair Parade after which the Board commended staff on a job well done for these entries.

She then provided a brief update on 100th year anniversary events including historical displays, Littlerock Dam and Leslie O. Carter Water Treatment Plant tours scheduled for the third Thursday of each month, a new logo, videos, and potential photo exhibit with photographs from former employee, Frank Collett, after which President Alvarado requested a letter of thanks from the Board be sent to Mr. Collett's widow for her generosity in sharing the photographs.

b) Outreach Plans for 2017.

She then stated that Imagine a Day Without Water is scheduled for October 12, and the District will provide elected officials a tour of District facilities to commemorate the event and that a Town Hall will be held in the spring after which President Alvarado requested City Planning Commissioners be invited to attend the tour.

c) Upcoming Events.

She then stated that a meeting is scheduled next week with Palmdale School District representatives to discuss partnering on projects after which Director Henriquez requested the District become involved in the school curriculum, and President Alvarado requested Director Mac Laren be invited to attend the meeting.

d) Outreach Recommendations From Directors.

Director Estes requested photographs of events where the District is a participant be posted on the Boardroom walls.

President Alvarado then inquired as to the rotation for the next Café Con Leche radio event and requested a tour of the Leslie O. Carter Water Treatment Plant be provided to the Palmdale School District's sister city delegates from Peru with Certificates of Participation provided.

- 7.8) Consideration and Possible Action on Authorization of the Following Conferences, Seminars, and Training Sessions for Board and Staff Attendance Within Budget Amounts Previously Approved in the 2017 Budget:
- a) WateReuse Symposium to be Held September 10 13, 2017 in Phoenix, Arizona. (Director Mac Laren)

After a brief discussion of this conference, it was moved by Director Mac Laren, seconded by Director Henriquez, and unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting to approve Board and staff attendance at the following conferences, seminars, and training sessions within budget amounts previously approved in the 2017 budget: WateReuse Symposium to be Held September 10-13, 2017 in Phoenix, Arizona.

7.9) Consideration and Possible Action on Opposition to SB 623.

General Counsel Dunn provided an overview of SB 623, the proposed statewide water tax imposed on all water customers throughout the state to provide funding to disadvantaged water systems to ensure safe drinking water, and after a brief discussion of the bill, of ACWA's recommendation to oppose the bill, of other water agencies opposing the bill, of proposed amendments to the bill, and of the need to further review the bill, it was moved by Director Henriquez, seconded by Director Estes, and carried on a 4-0-1 vote, with Director Mac Laren abstaining, for the District to take the position of "oppose unless amended" to SB 623, and the District's area representatives be informed of the District's position.

General Counsel Dunn then stated that he will provide links for more information on SB 623.

Director Dino reported that on August 16, he attended the informational Personnel Committee meeting; that on August 19, he participated in the Antelope

Director Henriquez reported that on August 17, he attended the Finance Committee meeting where they reviewed the items discussed earlier this evening; that on August 19, he participated in the Antelope Valley Fair Parade and commended staff on a job well done with the District's float; and that on August 21, he attended a Board briefing with General Manager LaMoreaux.

Director Estes reported that on August 22, he attended a Board briefing with General Manager LaMoreaux; that he was not able to attend the August 16 Personnel Committee meeting but is scheduled for a briefing on August 31 with Personnel Committee items to be presented to the full Board for consideration at the September 13, 2017 meeting; and that he will attend the next Palmdale Recycled Water Authority meeting for swearing in as an Alternate Director.

President Alvarado reported that on August 10, he attended mandatory sexual harassment training; that on August 15, he attended an agenda review and approval meeting with General Manager LaMoreaux and Executive Assistant Deans; that on August 17, he attended the Finance Committee meeting; that on August 19, he participated in the Antelope Valley Fair Parade; and that on August 22, he attended a Board briefing with General Manager LaMoreaux.

President Alvarado then requested an updated Organization Chart, and General Manager LaMoreaux stated that this will be presented to the Board at a later date.

General Counsel Dunn stated that he has no report followed by discussion of adding items to the agenda after the posting of the agenda and the opinions of ACWA and CSDA.

JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, CONSOLIDATED FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, AND THE FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ANTELOPE VALLEY CEMETERY DISTRICT, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALMDALE, AND OTHER AFFECTED TAXING ENTITIES, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE NEGOTIATED EXCHANGE OF PROPERTY TAX REVENUE RESULTING FROM ANNEXATION NO. 2017-03 TO THE ANTELOPE VALLEY CEMETERY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 99 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, for specified jurisdictional changes, the governing bodies of affected agencies shall negotiate and determine the amount of property tax revenue to be exchanged between the affected agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles, as the governing body of the County, the Consolidated Fire Protection District, and Flood Control District, and on behalf of the County Public Library, Road District No. 5, Lighting Maintenance District No. 1687, Waterworks District No. 37, and Waterworks District No. 40; and the governing bodies of the Antelope Valley Cemetery District; City of Palmdale; County Sanitation District No. 14 of Los Angeles County; County Sanitation District No. 20 of Los Angeles County; Antelope Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District; Antelope Valley Resource Conservation District; Antelope Valley-East Kern Water Agency; Castaic Lake Water Agency; Palmdale Water District; Newhall County Water District; Littlerock Creek Irrigation District; and Golden Valley Municipal Water District, have determined the amount of property tax revenue to be exchanged between their respective agencies as a result of the Antelope Valley Cemetery District Annexation No. 2017-03, as set forth below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The negotiated exchange of property tax revenue between the County of Los Angeles, as the governing body of the County, Consolidated Fire Protection District, and Flood Control District, and on behalf of the County Public Library, Road District No. 5, Lighting Maintenance District No. 1687, Waterworks District No. 37, and Waterworks District No. 40; Antelope Valley Cemetery District; City of Palmdale; County Sanitation District No. 14 of Los Angeles County; County Sanitation District No. 20 of Los Angeles County; Antelope Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District; Antelope Valley Resource Conservation District; Antelope Valley-East Kern Water Agency; Castaic Lake Water Agency; Palmdale Water District; Newhall County Water District; Littlerock Creek Irrigation District; and Golden Valley Municipal Water District, resulting from Annexation No. 2017-03, is approved and accepted.
- 2. For the fiscal year commencing in the year after the filing of the statement of boundary change for Annexation No. 2017-03, with the Board of Equalization pursuant to Government Code sections 54902 and 57204, and every fiscal year thereafter, the ratios of the annual property tax growth in the affected Tax Rate Areas as shown in Attachment A, shall be transferred to the Antelope Valley Cemetery District as a result of Annexation No. 2017-03 to the District. The other affected taxing entities' share of property tax growth in the affected Tax Rate Areas shall be adjusted as calculated by the Auditor-Controller of Los Angeles County.
- 3. There shall be no additional transfer of property taxes as a result of Annexation No. 2017-03.

- 4. No transfer of property tax revenues from properties within a community redevelopment project, which are deposited into a Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund (as created by California Health & Safety Code section 34170.5(b)) shall be made during the period that such revenues are legally committed for repayment of Enforceable Obligations (as defined by California Health & Safety Code section 34171 (d)).
- 5. If at any time after the effective date of this resolution, the calculations used herein to determine initial property tax transfers or the data used to perform those calculations are found to be incorrect, thus producing an improper or inaccurate property tax transfer, the property tax transfer shall be recalculated and the corrected transfer shall be implemented for the next fiscal year, and any amounts of property tax received in excess of that which is proper, shall be refunded to the appropriate agency.

RESOLUTION NO. 17-19

REIMBURSEMENT RESOLUTION FINANCIAL SECURITY PACKAGE PALMDALE REGIONAL GROUNDWATER RECHARGE AND RECOVERY PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Palmdale Water District (the "District") desires to finance the costs of constructing and/or reconstructing certain public facilities and improvements relating to Palmdale Regional Groundwater Recharge and Recovery Project, including groundwater wells, recharge basins, pipelines and other water delivery infrastructure (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the District intends to finance the construction and/or reconstruction of the Project or portions of the Project with moneys ("Project Funds") provided by the State of California, acting by and through the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board); and

WHEREAS, the State Water Board may fund the Project Funds with proceeds from the sale of obligations the interest upon which is excluded from gross income for federal income tax purposes (the "Obligations"), and

WHEREAS, prior to either the issuance of the Obligations or the approval by the State Water Board of the Project Funds the Agency desires to incur certain capital expenditures (the "Expenditures") with respect to the Project from available moneys of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that those moneys to be advanced on and after the date hereof to pay the Expenditures are available only for a temporary period and it is necessary to reimburse the District for the Expenditures from the proceeds of the Obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, ORDER AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The District hereby states its intention and reasonably expects to reimburse Expenditures paid prior to the issuance of the Obligations or the approval by the State Water Board of the Project Funds.

SECTION 2. The reasonably expected maximum principal amount of the Project Funds is \$57,400,000.

SECTION 3. This resolution is being adopted no later than 60 days after the date on which the District will expend moneys for the construction portion of the Project costs to be reimbursed with Project Funds.

SECTION 4. The District's expenditures will be of a type properly chargeable to a capital account under general federal income tax principles.

SECTION 5. To the best of our knowledge, the District is not aware of the previous adoption of official intents by the District that have been made as a matter of course for the purpose of reimbursing expenditures and for which tax-exempt obligations have not been issued.

SECTION 6. This resolution is adopted as official intent of the District in order to comply with Treasury Regulation §1.150-2 and any other regulations of the Internal Revenue Service relating to the qualification for reimbursement of Project costs.

SECTION 7. All the recitals in this Resolution are true and correct and the District so finds, determines and represents.
