A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Palmdale Water District was held Monday, February 12, 2024, at 2029 East Avenue Q, Palmdale, California, in the Board Room of the District Office. President, Kathy Mac Laren-Gomez, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance/Moment of Silence.

At the request of President Mac Laren-Gomez, Director Sanchez led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silence.

It was moved by Director Wilson, seconded by Director Dino, and carried on a 4-0-1 vote, with Director Sanchez abstaining, to approve the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting held February 12, 2024, as written.

General Manager LaMoreaux provided an overview of the commemorative event planning for the anniversary of Littlerock Reservoir and the additional work needed to clean the former concessionaire's site, and after a brief discussion of the United States Forest Service and of potential future partnerships for the return of recreational activities at the Reservoir, it was moved by Director Dino, seconded by Director Kellerman, and unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting to amend the approved Budget for an additional \$70,000.00 for the Littlerock Reservoir 100th Anniversary celebration.

Assistant General Manager Ly provided an overview of the proposed Agreement for domestic water service, including the deteriorating water quality from the property owner's well and the requirement of utilizing the existing well and storage tank for fire suppression and irrigation use, after which it was moved by Director Kellerman, seconded by Director Wilson, and unanimously carried by all members of the Board of Directors present at the meeting to approve the Substandard Water Service Agreement between Palmdale Water District and Thomas Miller.
