## WATER CYCLE DRAWING CONTEST WINNERS HONORED BY PWD BOARD ON EARTH DAY

Palmdale, CA – At its meeting on Monday, the Palmdale Water District (PWD) Board recognized a dozen students for their winning entries in the PWD Water Cycle Drawing Contest held in honor of Earth Day.

The winners' drawings were chosen from 200 pieces of artwork submitted by students at seven Palmdale K-8 schools. Asked to showcase the steps of the water cycle in their colored drawing, the students used pencils, crayon and markers to show the process in their own creative expressions.

Entries included colorful sketches showing the cycle of evaporation, transpiration, condensation and precipitation. Others used their drawings to encourage water conservation.

"It's great that we were able to recognize the winners on Earth Day at our Board meeting," said Water-Use Efficiency Specialist Robert Rosati.
