





To Whom it may concern:

I received a notice from the Palmdale Water District containing a proposed change and rate increase for water consumption for Palmdale residents. The notice explained that the owner of the residence who pays the charges may submit a written protest prior to the public hearing of November 4, 2024. Please count this as a protest against the rate increase for 2929 East Avenue R11, Palmdale, CA 93550.

My name is and I am an owner of this property. I work hard to maintain this property and pay the utility bills on time each month. Unfortunately, my job has not been very stable, and I have taken temp assignments with Temp Agencies while I search for full-time regular employment. The temp assignment I now have will be coming to a close very soon, then my only income will be Unemployment Insurance until I am able to find my next temp assignment or regular full-time job.

The notice I received states that the District will not adopt the rate increase if written protests are presented by a majority imposed, 50% +1. Only written protests will be counted, not oral protest presented at the hearing. Again, I wish to have a say in this protest, and I want my protest counted. The past four years have been incredibly hard for me. I was working a temp assignment in Valencia, CA, and was laid off due to the Covid Pandemic. I have never been able to get back on my feet since that layoff. The price of gasoline, groceries, and utility bills have grown so high, that my paycheck does not cover all my expenses. I am 58 years old, and am having a hard time planning my future financially. I do not know how I will ever be able to retire some day. If this proposed rate increase happens, I will consider moving out of California because I cannot make a living in this State.

I appreciate your letting me have a say in this proposed rate increase, and I hope you will give me consideration before raising my rates.

WRITTEN PROTEST TO WATER RATE CHANGES AND INCREASES

Palmdale Water District,

This letter is to protest the water rate changes and increases for Palmdale including our property which we own at 146 Deblynn Court. The rate increase of 11% for two consecutive years, then 9% the next year and 8% the following year is extremely high and exceeds inflation. Paying \$86 a month in 2029 for a basic necessity indicates poor management of funds.

The method for protesting is also extremely outdated and places the customer at a disadvantage. The Water Board must be aware that requiring its customers to send a paper letter to protest is a guaranteed way to raise the rate to whatever they wish. It is 2024 and email should be an acceptable way to communicate with the Palmdale Water District. All other communications such as paying water bills may completed online, this protest procedure should use the same electronic method.

There are many families in Palmdale who earn an average income and do not qualify for payment assistance. Those families are likely too busy to write up a protest letter over an absurd rate hike because they are too busy juggling all the other financial demands of daily life.

It is shocking how much of an increase the Water Board is demanding and will likely receive. This is a poor way to run a business but because this is a public utility the Water District can get away with such actions with zero consequences.

Please do not increase the cost of living again for Palmdale citizens.

Dear Members of the Palmdale Water District Board,

I am writing to respectfully protest the proposed water rate increases outlined in Proposition 218. As a disabled resident living on a fixed monthly Social Security income, with my husband shouldering the majority of our household expenses, these proposed increases would impose a significant financial burden on us. As new homeowners, having lived in Palmdale for just ten months, my family and I were drawn to the city for its affordability and quality of life. However, the potential rise in water rates is jeopardizing the stability we sought when we chose to settle here.

The proposed rate hikes —from \$54.43 to \$60.75 in 2025, ultimately rising to \$86.53 by 2029—represent a 59% increase over five years. For families like mine, this is simply unaffordable, especially when compounded with the current inflation rate of 3.7%. Additionally, the Tier 4 commodity charge increase from \$4.98 to \$7.09 per HCF will significantly raise monthly water bills, potentially adding hundreds of dollars in annual expenses for a typical family consuming around 20 HCF per month.

Palmdale already faces economic difficulties, with over 13.6% of the population living below the poverty line and close to 10% living with disabilities. Many of these residents, including myself, rely on fixed or limited incomes and would struggle to absorb such steep increases in the cost of essential services. I fear that these rate hikes could lead to financial instability for many families, forcing difficult decisions between basic needs.

While I fully understand the necessity of effective water management, particularly in droughtprone California, I believe there are alternative solutions that could help address these challenges without placing such a heavy financial strain on residents. Measures like increasing water efficiency, promoting conservation, and investing in new water reclamation technologies could offer more sustainable approaches to managing our water system without the need for steep rate increases.

I kindly urge the Board to reconsider these proposed rate hikes and explore more balanced alternatives that would protect residents from excessive financial burdens. Keeping water rates

stable is essential to ensuring that Palmdale remains an affordable and livable community, especially for its most vulnerable citizens.

Thank you for your attention to this matter and for considering my concerns.

I am the owner of the noted service address, and I cast **a No vote** regarding the proposed rate increase.

First, if I did my math right, I see an overall increase on the "Fixed monthly charge" that at the end of 5 years totals 37.7%. That averages out to being 7.54% per year. That's higher than most COLA's we receive. Next is the Tier 1 "Commodity Charge" which has an overall 42.2% rate increase at the end of a 5 year period or an average of 8.4% per year which once again is more than the average COLA increase. I just think that the proposed increases is just too much.

I would like to see a decrease in the "Fixed monthly charge" down to an average of 3% per month and then on the "Commodity Charge" see a rate increase of 5% on Tier1 and 15% (or more) on Tier 2 and above. This could stimulate more water conservation. I know this would be stepping back to how the District used to bill many years ago.

I have to wonder how well the District spends its money. I have noted the increase in positions that have been created with "Analysts" for example in their title. There seems to be a lot of jobs that are farmed out to outside firms, for example, an upcoming Board meeting (Oct. 14 2024) Action Item 7.1 has a proposal from an outside firm to do work for us for \$77,500. Its even noted that if the Board does not approve this recommendation "the work would be accomplished internally".

I have noticed that our windmill at the lake hasn't operated for a very long time. Why hasn't it been fixed? That was a large investment for the District and now it sits unused. Maybe the savings by not approving the above noted Action Item 7.1 might be enough to pay for fixing the windmill.

Once again, I cast a **no vote** for such a large rate increase. PWD needs to tighten its belt like the customers that it serves.

I am the resident and owner of my property at 5527 Katrina Place, Palmdale, CA 93552. I have lived at this residence since 2019. This letter is to protest all of the Fixed Monthly Charges, Commodity Charges per HCF and the Drought Surcharge per HCF.

First, the Palmdale Water District is seeking a 49% increase in five (5) years with the public paying an increase from the current prices to an increase of 59% - 62%. Water is the fundamental of life and with a mind-blowing increase each year, I believe there is some fiscal and monetary irresponsibility within the Palmdale Water District.

Second, the Commodity Charge has people paying from 73% to well over 120%. This charge should be no more than 2% increase across the board. People, farmers and residents should not be punished from using water.

I hird, the Drought Surcharge needs to be restricted to an increase of no more than .25% - .50% of the current price for all stages. We pay more during a drought; however, the people do not pay less during a surplus.

It is my belief that a company should be able to raise prices because of growing costs. However, it should be at a rate to where it would not punish the public. Palmdale Water District has not accrued more water resources; therefore, the unreasonable raises are not necessary. Do not raise the price of water outside the normal increase of a company that is financially responsible.




