LEARN TO MANAGE YOUR WATER USE AT PWD'S WATER- WISE WORKSHOP ON MAY 1

Palmdale, CA – Palmdale Water District (PWD) will host a free workshop to help customers increase their water management skills, including knowing how to locate water meters, understanding water bills, and practicing conservation tips.

The Water-Wise Workshop: Mastering Your Water Use is scheduled for 5-6 p.m. Thursday, May 1, at PWD's main office, 2029 East Avenue Q, Palmdale. To register for the event, visit <https://bit.ly/42odlZy>. All attendees will be entered into a raffle to win a \$200 smart Wi-Fi irrigation controller.

PWD's Water-Use Efficiency team will provide information on leak variance application and allocation forms for households with more than four individuals. The team will also discuss residential and commercial rebates available for high-efficiency toilets and clothes washers, sprinklers, flume meters, hot water recirculating pumps, and other water-saving tools and

appliances.

At the workshop, staff will provide information on how to apply for the Water-Wise Landscape Conversion Program, which offers residential customers up to \$3,000 in rebates and an unlimited amount for commercial accounts.

“This workshop is going to be packed with information that will help our customers better manage their water-saving skills and increase their knowledge of resources available to them,” said PWD Water-Use Efficiency Specialist Maria Avelar. “We hope many of our customers will take advantage of this free workshop to learn how they can save water and money.”
