## JOIN BOARD DIRECTOR DEBBIE DINO AT PWD COFFEE EVENT ON MAY 28

*Palmdale, CA* – For the first time since taking office in September, Palmdale Water District (PWD) Board Member Debbie Dino will be featured at Coffee with a PWD Director from 9-11 a.m. Thursday, May 28, at Starbucks, 38135 47<sup>th</sup> Street East, in Palmdale.

The community is invited to attend the event to meet Director Dino and enjoy a free Starbucks drink. She will be joined by PWD staff, including Assistant GM Scott Rogers and the Public Affairs staff, to answer questions about PWD or water issues.

Coffee with a PWD Director was started in 2018 to give customers the opportunity to get to know their representatives in a casual environment. Director Dino, who represents Division 5, was appointed last September to fill a seat left vacant by her late husband, Vincent Dino.

Director,” she said. “I attended many coffee events with Vince, but now I get to be the one to hear directly from the customers and do what I can to assist them as their representative on the PWD Board. I will be bringing some drought-tolerant plants to give to a few lucky attendees.”

Director Dino, a resident of Palmdale since 1994, serves as a director for the Antelope Valley Fair Board and for Kids Feeding Kids Through Agriculture. From 2016 to 2020, she was a Hearing Officer for the city of Palmdale.

Her appointed term expires in December. Division 5 covers an area roughly north of Highway 138 (Palmdale Boulevard) from 30th Street East to 47th Street East, east of 47<sup>th</sup> Street East to 80th Street East, and south to Avenue S.
